



## Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)



1. Can PG second-year students (3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> semester) apply for the scholarship?

Only the first year (1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester) students can apply for scholarships this year (2021).

2. I am basically from Kerala but now I reside in another state. Am I eligible for the scholarship?

Students whose permanent residence in Kerala can apply (Please see the full eligibility criteria given under the instructions)

3. I'm awaiting the results; can I apply for the scholarship/ Can I apply for the scholarship before getting a PG admission?

Given the delay in the declaration of results/ admission procedures due to the pandemic, students awaiting the results of UG and/or who are yet to secure admission to PG can apply. However, the candidature will be provisional until admission to the PG course.

4. Which proof regarding my PG admission should I attach?

The bonafide certificate issued by the head of the department can be used as proof of admission to the PG course. Given the difficulty in obtaining certificates in the current pandemic situation, you can choose to submit the bonafide certificate after the award of scholarship.

5. How to apply? Should I mail the scanned copies?

The application form (please see the proforma of the application form given under the instructions) completed in all respects along with the required certificates needs to be combined into a single pdf file. 6. Can I attach the reference letter of my UG teachers?

Yes. The reference letter can be obtained on a recent date from the dean/head of the department/faculty members (current/past) /research guide/ professionals in the field of psychology.
